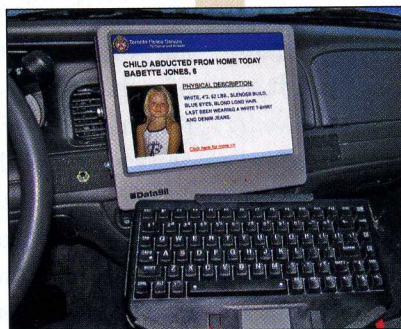

Push-button siren option

Siren-Operated Sensors offers a push-button option for its Siren-Operated Sensor (SOS). If gates open with a siren, the SOS Hold version will hold the gate open indefinitely until someone steps over to the SOS and presses the release button located on the outside of the enclosure. This option, for use with the SOS-II, does not effect the normal opening and closing of the gate by any other method, and it does not serve to open the gate if pressed. The Hold option can, at any time, be switched off on the inside control board. The SOS would then operate as usual to only trigger the gate to open or hold for a timed delay.
